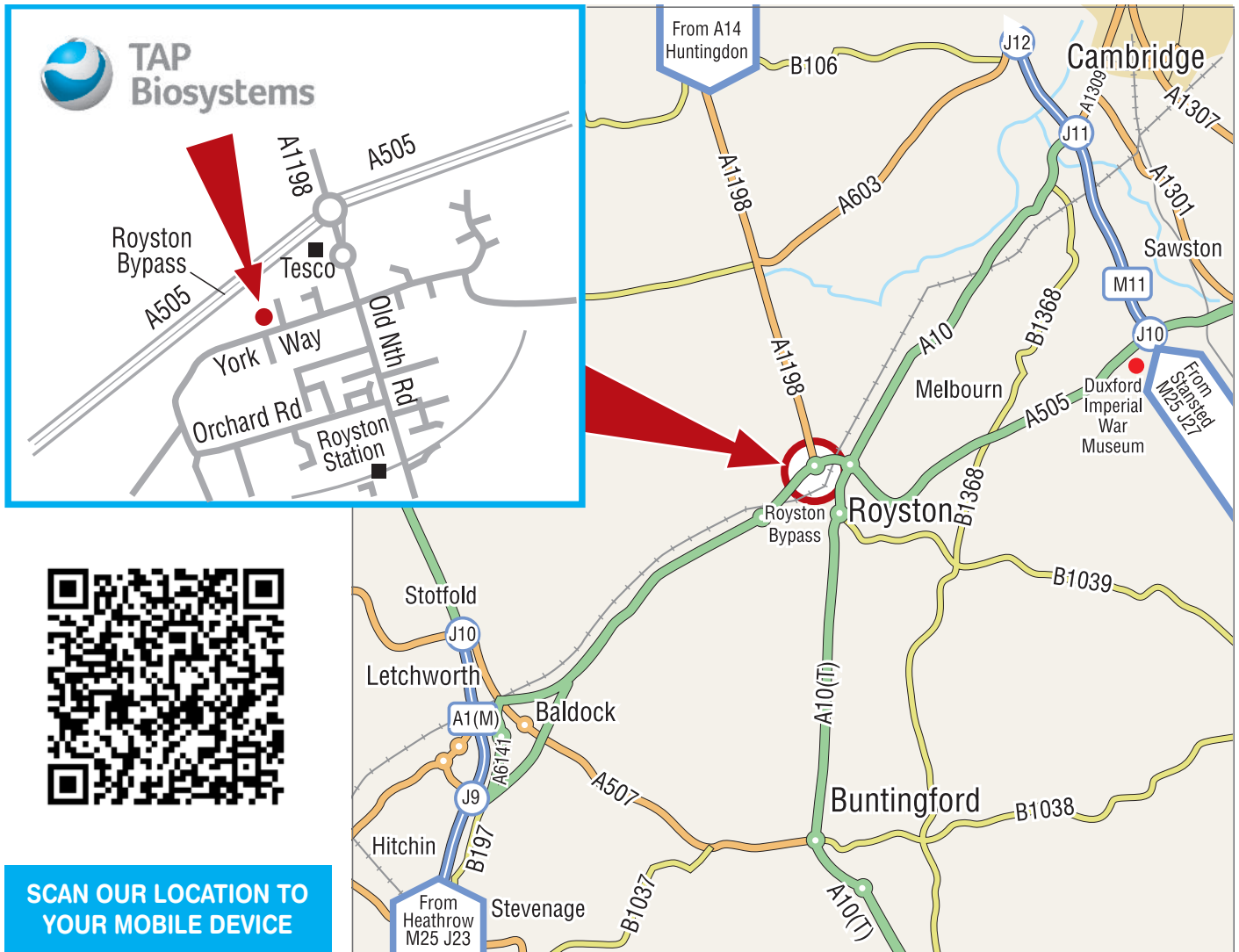


TAP Biosystems is located in Royston, Hertfordshire, close to Cambridge - the world-leading centre of life science research. We are easily accessible from London Stansted, Luton, Gatwick and Heathrow airports.



Directions by Road (sat nav postcode SG8 5WY)

From Heathrow Airport

M4 west to junction 4, then join M25 (at junction 15) towards Watford. Exit at junction 23 to join the A1 northbound (see map above).

From Gatwick Airport

M23 to junction 8, then join M25 at Reigate (junction 7). M25 east towards Dartford River crossing. Exit at junction 27 and join the M11 northbound at junction 6 (see map above).

From A1 (M)

Exit for Baldock at junction 10 (from the north) or junction 9 (from the south). In Baldock, join the A505 towards Duxford and Royston.

From A505 (Royston Bypass)

Turn at roundabout signposted towards Royston Railway Station. Go straight on at the first roundabout (Tesco Store on right), then turn right at the second roundabout onto York Way. Turn second right onto Grantham Close and left into the Visitor car park.

By Rail

Royston Station receives a regular service from London Kings Cross Station and Cambridge. TAP Biosystems is a 10 minute walk or a short taxi journey from the train station.

By Air

Heathrow and London Stansted are the more convenient airports.
